Instructions:

Service hours for Boy Scout rank advancement are to be made while the scout is in the previous rank. In other words, service performed while a boy is a First Class Scout can be used for the Star rank advancement requirement but cannot be used for the Life requirement. Approval from the Scoutmaster or Assistant Scoutmaster is required before the service is performed.

The service should be an individual initiative of the scout. Generally, service to any charitable organization other than the troop will meet the requirements for pre-approval. Rank advancement service hours must be a separate from service hours for conformation or a Religious Growth award. Troop sponsored service projects such as brush clearing on a campout typically does not count toward rank advancement.

Some common service projects: volunteer at Channel One, be an Acolyte, Mow or pick-up an elderly persons lawn, volunteer at the library, etc.
